## CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE:



In last Sunday's homily I quoted from Dr. Albert Schweitzer, the great Belgian Doctor and Missionary. He devoted sixty years of his life in the Belgian Congo caring for the victims of Leprosy.

He said that the Gospel parable of Lazarus and the rich man was a turning point in his life. He wrote, "The Gospel of Lazarus and the rich man helped me reach a decision about how I would spend my life. It struck me as incomprehensible that I should be allowed to have such a happy life while so many people around me were wrestling with poverty and suffering".

*The following was submitted to the State Bulletin:*

The history of the Knights of Columbus in this area dates back to 1910, when Councils formed in Berlin (Kitchener) and Guelph.

Following World War II Brothers who had joined Galt Council 2184 saw a need for a separate Council in Preston-Hespeler to serve the needs of their separate communities and parishes.

These brothers along with new recruits from the two communities were the charter members of Monsignor Paul J. Meyer Council 4916.

The Council received its charter November 19, 1960.

On June 6, 2010, Council 4916 began the Celebration of our 50th Anniversary with a Mass At St. Clement Parish celebrated by Bishop Anthony Tonnos, Bishop of Hamilton.

The Mass was followed by a social and Dinner at our Council Hall attended by some of the Charter members as well as about 200 people. Attendees were extended greetings from our Grand Knight Daniel Schmalz, Clergy, other Councils, Local politicians and the City of Cambridge Mayor Doug Craig. Greetings were brought from State by State Advocate Dan Heffernan.

The head table was piped in and the attendees enjoyed the Preston Scout House Band presentation prior to the wonderful meal. The Master of Ceremonies, Brother Paul O'Neill thanked Brother Wilf Rettinger and his Committee for their efforts in putting together the function and also thanked the Fourth Degree Honour Guard for their attendance. Thanks was extended to the Charter members in attendance for their foresight and courage in establishing this Council and a challenge was presented to the present members to take up the torch and carry it high for another 50 years for Msgr. Paul J. Meyer Council 4916.
