I would like to thank all my Brother Knights for all their help both inside and outside the building. We still have trouble with people dumping garbage on

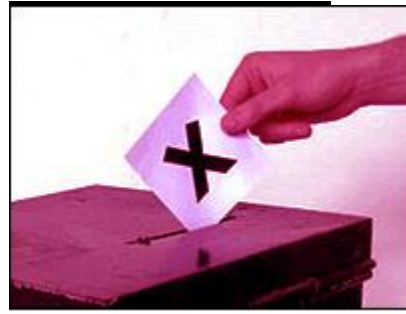
our property even though we have posted signs.

### ***Knight of the Year:***

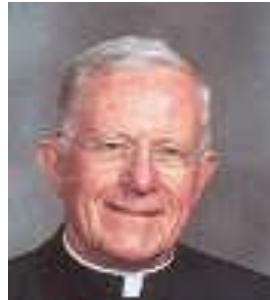

### ***Family of the Year:***

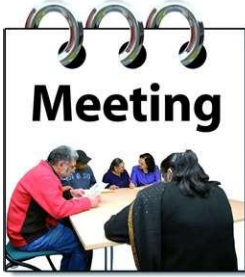
